

MANCHESTER METROPOLITAN FOUNDATION YEAR

Our Foundation Year is a 1-year programme, delivered on campus, for students who do not have the qualifications to enter directly onto an honours degree (e.g. BA or BSc). Once you have passed the Foundation Year you will progress directly onto Year 1 of the linked degree. Students requiring a Tier 4 Student Visa can apply for one visa covering both the Foundation Year and the main undergraduate degree.

COURSE CONTENT

You will study a Foundation Year unit designed to develop your academic and study skills and three units relevant to your chosen subject. International students are placed on the Foundation Year International Route, which offers additional English language study skills and tutor support.

FOUNDATION DIPLOMA IN ART AND DESIGN

This one-year course will enable you to develop the necessary skills and portfolio to apply to a range of art and design degree courses. The English requirement for this course is IELTS UKVI 5.5 overall, with no element below 5.0, and students will be required to submit a satisfactory digital portfolio as part of the admission process.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Academic: 72-80 UCAS Tariff Points (Grades BC/BB) at A2 or international equivalent – generally students will need to have completed a Secondary School qualification and 12 years of education. English: IELTS 5.5 overall, with no element below 5.5
