About the Law LLB course (UCAS code: M100)

The LLB at The Dickson Poon School of Law is a highly regarded course, recognised around the world for its teaching excellence. You will be taught by academics who are leaders in their field based in the heart of legal London. Our Law LLB course focuses on the study of law as an intellectual discipline. It can form the first major step towards qualifying as a solicitor or barrister, but also represents appropriate preliminary training for a range of other careers.

LLB pathways

After your first year of the Law LLB you have the option of applying to study one of the following dual degree or study abroad pathway options:

Law with American Legal Studies

LLB Four-year degree offering you a fantastic opportunity to spend one year studying law at one of our partner universities in the United States.

Law with Transnational Legal Studies

LLB Four-year degree with the opportunity to spend at least one semester at the Centre of Transnational Legal Studies plus the option of spending one semester at a university in the United States.

Law with European Legal Studies

LLB Four-year degree with the opportunity to spend one year studying law at one of our many partner universities in Europe.

Law with Australian Law LLB Four-year degree with the opportunity to spend one year studying in Australia.

English Law & American Law LLB and JD

Four-year dual degree with the opportunity to spend two years at one of our partner universities in the United States from which you obtain a Juris Doctor.

English Law with Hong Kong Law LLB and LLM Three-year dual degree with the opportunity to spend one year at one of our partner universities in Asia from which you'll obtain an LLM.
