Graduate Immigration Route (Post Study Work Visa)

From the summer of 2021, there will be a new Graduate Immigration Route visa. Undergraduate and Master's students will be able to apply to stay for 2 years. PhD students will be able to apply to stay for 3 years. International students with a Student Route visa who will complete their course in or after the summer of 2021 will be eligible to apply.
