Why you should study with us

- The University of Dundee is listed on the major Saudi scholarship lists, including the Ministry of Education.
- We have over 150 Saudi students on campus with an active Saudi Society.
- #1 in Scotland and #14 in the UK for the proportion of graduates entering high skilled employment in the UK (87.4%). (Graduate Outcomes Survey, HESA 2020)
- Dundee is a safe multicultural city. There are a wide variety of halal restaurants and food stores within walking distance of the University.
- Our campus also has prayer rooms for both males and females. The central Dundee mosque is a 10-minute walk away.

Typical entry requirements

Undergraduate

Year 1: Students who have done a post-secondary diploma OR a foundation programme in a relevant subject area will be considered for first year entry.

Year 2: Direct entry to 2nd year is often possible for certain courses with A' Level or IB grades OR if the student meets the Level 1 requirements and has undertaken further studies towards a relevant University level qualification at a recognised institution.

With a minimum of 60% in the Saudi General Secondary Education Certificate with you may be eligible for our Foundation programme (International Year One), find more information at: www.uod.ac.uk/icd

Postgraduate

A 4-year Bachelor's degree with a GPA of at least 3.10 from a well ranked institution (UK equivalent 2.2). Some courses might require a GPA of 3.5-4.39 (UK equivalent 2.1)

Graduate destinations

English language requirements

Undergraduate Typical Undergraduate IELTS: Overall 6.0, Listening 5.5, Reading 5.5, Writing 6.0, Speaking 5.5 (some courses may require higher grades).

Postgraduate Typical Postgraduate IELTS: Overall 6.5, Listening 6.0, Reading 6.0, Writing 6.0, Speaking 6.0 (some courses may vary)

Global Excellence scholarship requirements

Undergraduate A Level AAB or above / SAT 1340 / IB Diploma: 35 points

Postgraduate Typically, the equivalent of a UK 1st Class Honours degree or a Saudi 4-year Bachelor's degree with a GPA of 4.0 or above.

- Our Global Excellence scholarship offers a £5,000 discount per year of study for high achieving students.
- Those who do not meet these scholarship requirements are still able to apply, and may receive a £5,000 discount on the first year of study.
- Students who have demonstrated other achievements, such as extra-curricular and/or voluntary activities, may also be considered.

Fees

- Our 2020/21 international tuition fees for postgraduate taught degrees range from **£18,150** to **£21,950** per year (approximately SAR 91300 to 110410 depending on currency rates)
- Certain professional courses, such as Medicine and Dentistry, may have higher fees.
