Unique experience

Scotland is home to the highest concentration of universities in Europe, strong varied industry sectors, cosmopolitan cities and international festivals, offering international students a truly unique study experience.

Beautiful landscape

Scotland's scenery and landscape are world renowned, from ancient forests to beautiful lochs and one of "The World's Outstanding Coastlines (National Geographic)". Only a short distance from Aberdeen lies some of the most spectacular mountain ranges in the world as well as Cairngorm National Park – the largest National Park in Britain.

Adventure sports

If excitement is what draws you, Scotland is home to thrilling adventure activities such as bungee jumping, white water rafting, scuba diving, mountain biking, skiing, snowboarding, mountain climbing and surfing.

Castle country

Aberdeenshire is known as Scotland's Castle Country with over 250 castles in the region, including Balmoral Castle - Scotlish residence of the Queen.

Vibrant city

With a population of 228,000 Aberdeen is the third most populated city in Scotland and the country's most international city with 17% of residents non-British nationals (National Registers of Scotland 2019). That's over 34,000 international residents! Combine this with the 30,000 students who call the city home and Aberdeen is the perfect study destination for international students.

Local culture

Aberdeen has captivating museums, a fascinating history, a wealth of art and culture and a lively social scene. Combine this with a variety of shops, restaurants, cafés, bars, cinemas, music venues all easily accessible within the city and Aberdeen is

perfectly set up for students. Many of these local businesses can also be a great source of part-time work.

Transport links

As a city with a vast business community Aberdeen has an extensive transport network and boasts an international airport just 5 miles away from the city centre. The city is very well connected, with regular rail and bus links that allow you to easily explore Scotland and the rest of the UK. Take a short flight to London in just over an hour, or Paris in two!

Energy capital

The energy industry is of huge value to the Aberdeen region. Aberdeen is a global centre of excellence for the research, development and sustainability of the industry – this is why many multinational oil and gas companies, such as BP, Shell and Total, choose to have major offices based within the city.





Student life

RGU:Union

RGU:Union supports students by providing opportunities and services to get involved and have the best student experience during their studies here in Aberdeen.

On progression to the University, ICRGU students are eligible to run in the yearly elections for a variety of positions such as Vice President or President. Former ICRGU students have held positions as both Student Vice President as well as the full-time Student President of Robert Gordon University student union.

Student societies

There are over 40 societies at RGU and students add more every year! From course-related groups to clubs that pull together students from across the University.

Student media

As a student at RGU, of any course, you are welcome to join the Student Media clubs on campus, including RGU:Radio, RGU:TV and Radar Magazine. From running your own radio show to presenting/filming RGU: TV - there are great opportunities for students to learn new skills or develop their passion for all things media related.

Sports facilities

Health and fitness is an important part of any lifestyle, support this with the RGU Sport building which offers students the opportunity to access a state-of-the-art gym, swimming pool and climbing wall. RGU Sport is also the home of 34 sports clubs, from basketball and rugby to rowing and mountain biking.

Campus security

ICRGU is located in the centre of the Garthdee campus, an area designed with the safety and happiness of students in mind. The campus is fully staffed, so even if you are studying in the library during the evening you can be sure that you will feel safe.









ResLife

ResLife is a support network designed for all students in accommodation, with a goal to enhance your living experience whilst at university. The team regularly organise a variety of trips and events so you can get to know what Aberdeen and the surrounding area have to offer. Student support

Accommodation

ICRGU students are eligible to apply for Robert Gordon University accommodation. RGU manages five different halls of residence in locations throughout Aberdeen city, including options that are near the University campus.

Cost of living

In 2018, Aberdeen was named as the most affordable city in Scotland for students (NatWest, 2018).

The cost of living can vary greatly depending on your lifestyle, budget and spending habits.

Applying to ICRGU

English language requirements

To attain entry into the undergraduate or postgraduate programme, you must be able to demonstrate you have a suitable level of English proficiency. You can do this by obtaining one of the results shown in the table below.

Undergraduate:

IELTS Academic/UKVI 5.5 with no band below 5.5

Postaraduate:

IELTS Academic/UKVI 6.0 with no band below 5.5

ICRGU is also able to accept evidence of English competency through a wide range of other qualifications including GCSE, WAEC, NECO, HKDSE, UCE and International Baccalaureate (IB) and others.

RGU ELT

The Robert Gordon University English Language Test is now offered globally. The test assesses the English language level of students in the four skills of listening, speaking, writing and reading.

The test can be used as evidence of English ability for application to ICRGU.

To register for the RGU English Proficiency Test, students will be able to make a booking online using their 6-digit student ID.

Pre-sessional English

ICRGU offers 20 to 25 hours a week of English language classes, for either ten or thirteen weeks directly before each academic intake for students who do not meet the English language requirements listed above.

Successful completion of the English language course will guarantee you a place on your chosen academic course. Your student Tier 4 Visa covers the full duration of your English and academic studies through to graduation from Robert Gordon University.

By completing the English language course, you will:

- · increase your understanding
- improve your pronunciation, grammatical skills and reading comprehension
- develop a broad, academically useful vocabulary
- · become confident at public speaking and delivering presentations
- build on your writing skills for essays, reports and assignments.
