#### **Graduate Immigration Route (Post Study** Work Visa)

The Graduate Immigration Route (GIR) launched on 1 July 2021. This route is a new post study graduate visa. The visa is for 2 years for Undergraduate and Master's students. If you are studying a PhD level course this visa is for 3 years. International students with a Student Route visa who complete their course in or after the summer of 2021 will be eligible to apply. 



For postgraduate courses, most require IELTS 6.5, with no component below 6.0 or equivalent.

- 96–120 UCAS points from 2–3 A levels
- IB 24-31 points
- SAT 1160 in SAT Reasoning and Three SAT Subject tests with scores of 600,580,580 and a GPA of 3.0/4
- Al Thanawiya (General Secondary Education Certificate) 60% or higher (entry to ICP)
- Moroccan Baccalaureat with a GPA of 15 or above
- Baccalauréat Général with a score of 12.5/20 or higher or the Option Internationale du Baccalauréat (OIB) with a score of 11.5/20 or higher
