

Your pathway course will help you to develop your subject knowledge, English language level and academic skills to meet the entry requirements for your chosen degree. If you pass at the required level, you're guaranteed entry to your University of Birmingham degree.

# WHERE WILL I STUDY?

The foundation pathways provide you with a fully integrated experience, which means you will be taught by Birmingham academics and have full access to all the facilities at the University of Birmingham's beautiful Edgbaston campus. You will be a Birmingham student from day one, taking part in classes across the campus, as well as at the home of the foundation pathways, Priorsfield. You are also guaranteed University accommodation during your foundation pathway if you apply by the deadline.
