English Language Requirements*

For all EPS and SSH UG Programmes we accept Academic IELTS 6.0 (min 5.5 in each section) or TOEFL iBT 78 or Pearson 57.

HLS UG Programmes we accept Academic IELTS 6.5 (min 6.0 in each section) or TOEFL iBT 93 or Pearson 63.

ABS UG Programmes we accept Academic IELTS 6.5 (min 5.5 in 2 bands) or TOEFL iBT 93 or Pearson 63.

For the MBChB Medicine programme we accept Academic IELTS 7.0 (min 7.0 in each section) or TOEFL iBT 109.
