English Language Requirements*

For PG programmes (including MBA) we accept Academic IELTS 6.0 - 6.5 (1 band at 5.5 or 6.0 as a minimum, depending on the course), or TOEFL iBT 93 or Pearson 63 except for:

- OSPAP Academic IELTS 7.0 (min of 7.0 in each section) or TOEFL iBT 101 or Pearson 65.
- Online courses Students who haven't done any of the above tests, can apply with a Password test
