Undergraduate:

• IB Diploma or A-Levels. Students can also undertake a Foundation Year.

Masters:

• A Bachelors degree with a minimum CGPA of 3.0/5.0 or 2.8/4.0.

English language requirements:

Please check individual courses for English language level:

- Standard: an IELTS score of 6.0 overall, with at least 5.5 in each of the four components
- High: an IELTS score of 6.5 overall, with at least 6.0 in each of the four components
- Advanced: an IELTS score of 7.0 overall, with at least 6.5 in each of the four components.
