Graduate Immigration Route (Post Study Work Visa)

The Graduate Immigration Route (GIR) launched on 1 July 2021. This route is a new post study graduate visa. The visa is for 2 years for Undergraduate and Master's students. If you are studying a PhD level course this visa is for 3 years. International students with a Student Route visa who complete their course in or after the summer of 2021 will be eligible to apply. - IB 24–31 points
- SAT 1160 in SAT Reasoning and Three SAT Subject tests with scores of 600,580,580 and a GPA of 3.0/4
- Al Thanawiya (General Secondary Education Certificate) 60% or higher (entry to ICP)

Postgraduate

- 2.6/4 GPA or 70% average
