The degree is taught in English and normally requires the completion of 96 credit points where 48 credit points is a usual full-time load for one academic year.

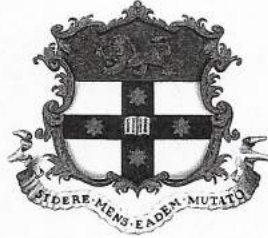
