A health declaration form will be sent out to you in advance through our Occupational Health Service.

PVG (PROTECTING VULNERABLE GROUPS) CHECK

Your enhanced disclosure check will be carried out through Disclosure Scotland's Protecting Vulnerable Groups Scheme (PVG), and the application form will be completed during Induction Week. You will need to bring the following documentation with you:

- Three forms of official identification such as passport, birth certificate and driving licence
- Details of home address(es) for the past five years and the dates you resided at each address
- Any previous PVG record

LOCAL POLICE CHECK

If you are living outside Scotland you are also required to complete a police check from your home country prior to starting the programme.
