You have been assessed as Overseas for fee purposes. This means you will be charged our International tuition fees. The tuition fees shown above are for the academic year 2023/24. For students admitted in September 2023 on courses lasting more than one year, these fees are set to increase each year over the duration of the degree by 3% each year (subject to rounding for administrative purposes and assuming you do not have a break in your studies). Please be aware that tuition fees vary depending on the degree course; if you are considering changing course please check the Fees section in the course description at www.sussex.ac.uk/study/masters.


